## **Village Council approves**

### **Textile Recycling Program for Palatine Residents**

**At the March 7, 2022 Village Council Meeting, the Village Council approved an agreement with Simple Recycling to begin a Village-wide residential textile recycling program. Beginning Monday March 28, residents in Palatine will be able to request a front door pickup via Simple Recycling's website or phone line for textiles that residents want to recycle. Rather than being disposed of in a landfill or incinerated, materials collected would be recycled as material for insulation or car seat filler. Simple Recycling's website states that the average person throws away 68 pounds of clothing per year. Clothing and housewares account for approximately 10% of the municipal waste stream and 85% of clothing does not get recycled or donated but thrown away.**
